(2019 - present)

- Providing specialist neuropsychological input within a multidisciplinary regional neurorehabilitation centre.
- Providing assessment, formulation and intervention for individuals experiencing complex cognitive, behavioural and emotional difficulties following neurological injury or illness.
- Developing interventions to support cognitive rehabilitation and positive behavioural support within an inpatient multidisciplinary setting.
- Providing therapeutic interventions and psychological support for patients and their families.
- Providing training and consultation to the multidisciplinary team.

Clinical Neuropsychologist, Neuropsychiatry Outpatient Service, Walkergate Park

(2018 - 2019)

- Providing neuropsychological input into a specialist neuropsychiatry multidisciplinary community team at Walkergate Park.
- Neuropsychological assessment, formulation and intervention to support individuals presenting with complex cognitive, emotional and behaviour changes as the result of a neurological condition or injury.
- Consultation to support development and implementation of positive behavioural support programmes within community settings.

Clinical Psychologist, Northumberland Head Injury Service, Northumberland

(2014 - 2018)

- Providing neuropsychological input within a community multidisciplinary team. The service provided an integrated health and social care service for individuals that had experienced a traumatic brain injury.
- Working as a member of an MDT to support individuals who had suffered a traumatic brain injury to maximize their functional and cognitive recovery.
